PUPIL ATTITUDE SURVEY 2019 RESULTS

INTRODUCTION

Each year we seek the views of the children at Queensmead Primary Academy about various aspects of their education, attitude to learning and approach to homework.

The outcomes below are the children's own views on the different questions asked. These questions were completed independently so that children could give their honest and true opinion on each topic.

This helps us to better understand the work of our academy, what we do well and the areas we need to improve from the perspective of the pupils.

We use this information, alongside the Parent Questionnaire and internal monitoring and evaluation, to update the academy development plan so that we can do things better for our pupils.

OVERALL OUTCOMES

What are the most positive aspects of pupil's attitudes at Queensmead?

Q2	I enjoy the learning in class	90%
Q4	People think this is a good school	94%
Q5	My teacher tells me how well I am doing in my work	98%
Q6	The teachers in my school take action when they see anyone breaking rules	97%
Q7	My school has sensible rules	97%
Q8	I know how to get better at writing and maths	90%
Q12	When teachers give me feedback, they tell what I must do to improve	99%
Q15	Do you think the discipline in your school is about right or too strict?	97%

What areas do we need to improve or get better at doing?

Q10	I can explain my targets and what I need to do to improve my work	88%
