Year 4 Visit to Bradgate Park

As part of the topics covered this year, we have arranged for Year 4 to spend the day at Bradgate Park. The visit will be on Tuesday 22nd February 2022, normal school times will apply on this day. **Children will need to bring a packed lunch for the day, any child who is entitled to Free School Meals will have a packed lunch provided for them, this can be requested via Parentpay.**

Please ensure that all containers are disposable, so that all rubbish can be thrown away. Drinks are to be in plastic bottles, not glass bottles and please no fizzy drinks, sweets or chocolate. Your child will be carrying their lunch around with them for the first part of the morning so please could it be put in backpack or draw string bag (their PE bag would be fine.)

Your child will be required to wear their school uniform. They must also wear a coat and shoes suitable for outdoor activities (trainers would be ideal).

The 1988 Education Act changed the rules regarding charging for educational visits. Whilst we are not allowed to charge for visits which take place primarily in school time, we must ask for a voluntary contribution to cover transport and insurance costs.

We are therefore asking for a voluntary contribution of £4.00 per child, in order that the trip may go ahead as planned. If we do not receive sufficient contributions the trip may need to be cancelled.

Contributions and permissions for this trip will need to be made via ParentPay.

If you haven't yet set up your ParentPay account please do, at your earliest convenience as we are no longer accepting cash in the academy. If you require a PayPoint barcode or have misplaced your registration letter please email: admin@queensmeadacademy.org with your child's name and we will arrange to send this out to you.

All children will be treated equally, regardless of whether you are making a voluntary contribution or not. However, in the exceptional circumstances of insufficient contributions being made, the school reserves the right to cancel the proposed visits and refund any contributions already received.
